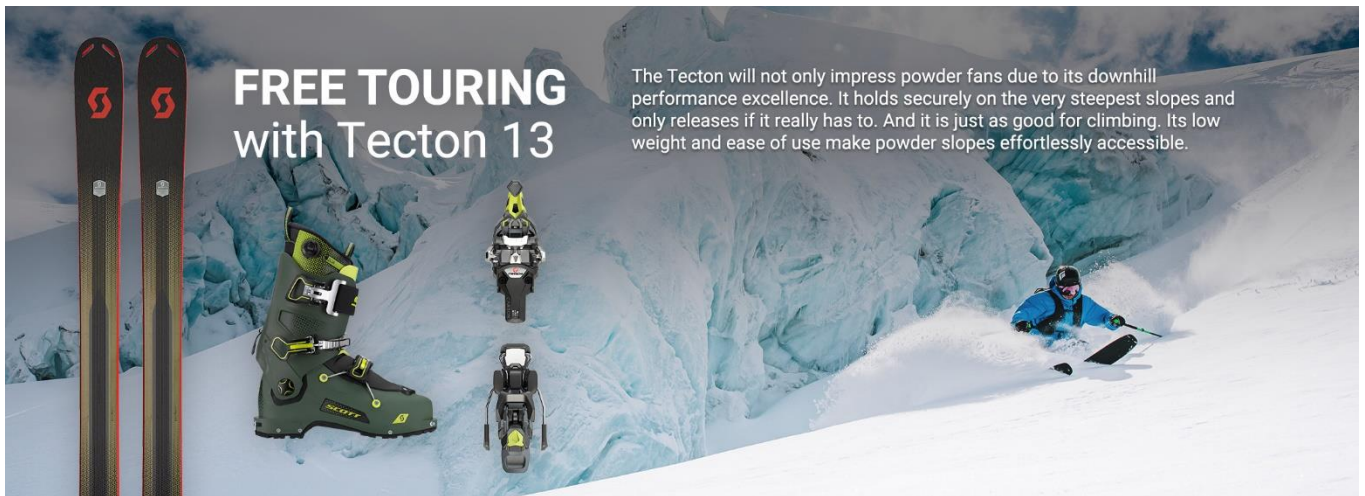




As a guide, we have created the following overview (list is not exhaustive) of current shoe models regarding compatibility with the Fritschi Tecton 13. Only boots with inserts are considered.

It is important to ensure that the system ski - binding - boot in itself and as a whole corresponds to the area of use.
